United States Military Service Academy

2020 Nomination Application Packet

Acceptance at a Military Academy involves at least a nine-year obligation: four years at the Academy and a minimum of five years of active duty service in the United States Military. You are obligated to serve in the United States Military at the beginning of your junior year at the Academy. It is in your best interest to request a nomination through all sources available to you: Presidential, Vice Presidential, Senatorial and Congressional. If either of your parents is currently on active duty and has served for at least eight years, or is retired from active duty or the Reserves, or was killed in action, then you may qualify for a Presidential nomination. Please check with the Admissions Office of your respective Military Academy for more details. The eligibility requirements are set forth by the academies themselves. In addition to submitting a complete nomination application to Congressman Delgado, applicants must directly contact their respective academy to open an admission file.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

As of July 1st of the year of admission, applicants must be:

- 17 years of age, but not yet 23 years old (25 years old for the United States Merchant Marine Academy)
- A citizen of the United States
- Unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support a child or dependent
- A legal resident of New York's 19th Congressional District

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

To be considered for a nomination by Congressman Delgado, each applicant must submit a **complete** Application Packet to the Congressman's Kingston District Office (256 Clinton Ave. Kingston, NY 12401) **on or before 5:00pm on October 30, 2020**; late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Each packet must contain the following items:

- **Application Form** (pages 2-3 in this packet)
- **Extra- Curricular Activities Worksheet** (page 4 in this packet)
- **Nomination Board Questionnaire** (pages 5-9 in this packet)
- **Three Letters of Recommendations:** One letter should be written by your High School Principal or Guidance Counselor. Other letters may be written by teachers, coaches, scout masters, clergy or community leaders who can accurately comment and attest to your character, abilities and potential success at a Military Academy. Letters should be sealed and submitted with the application packet.
- **Official SAT/ACT Scores:** Scores must be sent directly to Congressman Delgado's Office by the testing service. The institution code for SAT scores is 2885 and the ACT scores code is 7562.
- **Official High School Transcript:** Please include a copy of your Senior Class Schedule. Senior grades should be submitted as soon as they are available and will be accepted after the application deadline.
- **Note:** Please do not staple items in your application packet.

INTERVIEWS

Applicants who submit a complete nomination packet on or before October 30, 2020 at 5:00pm, will be reviewed by Congressman Delgado's Military Service Academy Selection Board; Candidates will then be invited to be interviewed by the Board. This well-qualified, non-partisan Board ensures a fair and impartial nomination process that not only considers academic and extracurricular success but is mindful to the various challenges and experiences facing students and families.
